How to Lead a Food, Clothing, or Hygiene Drive

Leading a food, clothing, and/or hygiene drive with your community is a great way to build comradery and do your part to prevent homelessness in Seattle. They're also very easy (and fun) to put together!

1. **Print out this document (single sided):** [Queen Anne Helpline Drive Info](#)
 - a. Find this page on our website – go to queenannehelpline.org/donate-in-kind and click the button that says “Print-Out”
 - b. **Note:** If you are only doing a Clothing Drive, you only need to print out pages 1 and 2.
2. **Get a bucket/bbox/bin** for donations and tape the sheets to it.
3. **Tell your community** about this (and remind them)!
4. After 2-6 weeks....
5. **Bring items to Queen Anne Helpline.** We accept donations on Mondays from 10am-2pm, and Thursday from 10am-6pm. Our location is 311 West McGraw St, Seattle, WA, 98119
 - a. Optional – we'd love if you **took pictures and posted about it on your newsletter/social media!** You could also post a photo of your community with some of them holding the basket, or something else.

What is Queen Anne Helpline?

Queen Anne Helpline is a small, local nonprofit that provides rental assistance, clothing and linens, shelf-stable food, and other resources that bolster our neighbors' ability to stay housed and healthy. We've offered these services since 1982, and we uplift hundreds of people in our community each year. **The work we do, which is funded primarily by individual members of our community, prevented 415 evictions in 2025.** You can learn more about us at queenannehelpline.org.
